WALRUS RODEO

Helmed by chef Jeff Maxfield, in partnership with Boia De's Luciana Giangrandi and Alex Meyer, Walrus Rodeo dishes out wood-fired concepts such as the rodeo 'za with anchovies, spicy tomatoes and maple-brown butter; or the mustard green lasagna with lamb ragu.
